Re-elect Stolman for Lake County Board

Lake County is facing some important issues, namely flood control and road improvements.

That is why incumbent Commissioner **David B. Stolman** of Buffalo Grove should be returned to the Lake County Board 20th District seat. The county needs an experienced negotiator to get things done.
